









## FIRE SEASON INFORMATION

**Campfires** are NOT permitted at any time during the PROHIBITED Burning Period from 1 November 2020 to 31 March 2021 (Note; these dates are subject to change according to conditions)

During the RESTRICTED BURNING PERIODS (19 September to 31 October & 15 February to 31 March) please observe the following requirements in relation to campfires. Use of wood and solid fuel BBQ's and wood fired pizza ovens are permitted during the Restricted and Prohibited Burning Periods, in accordance with the table below.

Please Note: Campfires are **NOT permitted** on public land unless purpose built campfire pits have been provided by the owner of the land and permission to use them has been given (during restricted period only). The taking of wood is **strictly prohibited** from Reserves, please bring your own wood supplies.
